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
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# Welcome to Oscos-Eo with children

It's no wonder one of its municipalities, Santa Eulalia de Oscos, has been chosen as the Rural Tourism Capital of 2024. Ideal for reconnecting and enjoying time with the little ones.



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# Easy and fun excursions

Between mountains and rivers, Oscos-Eo winds its way through secondary roads that connect from Castropol or Ribadeo. Access is easy, but the experience begins as you travel. Hidden villages, forest paths, and unexpected viewpoints await you on every journey. By car, bike, or on foot, getting around the region is part of the journey: everything invites you to stop, observe, and continue exploring.

## Castropol-Figueras Promenade

8 km (round trip) | +50 m elevation gain  
Coastal path with views of the estuary, ideal for sunset.

8 km | +100 m elevation gain  
Between forges and mills, to see how people lived in the past.

Short, easy, and with a surprise ending: an old, illuminated mine.

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
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## Route with art – Santa Eulalia de Oscos

# Activities to do with children

In Oscos-Eo, crafts aren't on display; they're lived. Artisans, ranchers, and farmers open their homes so families can learn by doing. Touching wool, watching the spark of iron, or feeding a calf. Here, everything is an experience: real, simple, and direct.



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## Agricultural experience at fabEO

(Saint Eulalia of Oscos)

Immerse yourself in authentic Asturian rural life with a visit to Fabeo, a picturesque farm producing PGI Asturian Faba beans located in Abres. We are Rocio and Javi, the hosts of the Torre de la Alcandra Rural Apartments and producers of one of the best PGI Asturian fabas at fabEO. This unique experience will allow you to learn firsthand about the planting, harvesting, and selection process of the prized Asturian faba bean, a gem of local cuisine.

## Viduedo Farmhouse

(Saint Eulalia of Oscos)

The Viduedo farm is an organic livestock farm where animals are raised in close contact with the environment. The owners invite you to visit their farm and see all their animals on a marked circular trail, which takes approximately one hour. Among the various animals you can see are: Asturian valley and mountain cows, Xalda and dwarf sheep, Pita Pinta chickens, roosters, Asturcone horses, red goats, Asturcelta pigs, geese, and cats.

## Workshops with Artesanamente

(Saint Eulalia of Oscos)

Surrounded by nature, little ones can learn to make baskets, candles, soaps, or natural cosmetics as a family. Creative activities that combine play, tradition, and sustainability.

## Mazonovo Mallet

### (Santa Eulalia de Oscos)

An old forge that's still in operation. Here, boys and girls can forge their own nail with the help of a blacksmith. Living tradition, fire, and emotion in its purest form.

## The Teixóis

### (Taramundi)

Ethnographic site with working hydraulic machines. A magical visit to understand how people lived and worked with the power of water.

## The House of Water

### (Bres, Taramundi)

A learning space to discover how old mills and hydraulic mechanisms work. Ideal for learning while playing.

## Interactive Museum of the Mills

### (Mazonovo, Taramundi)

A unique space where young and old can see how water powers ancient mechanisms, turns wheels, and grinds their own grain to take flour home . Ideal for curious and active children.

# Beaches to go with children

Peñarronda is a wide, fine-sand beach with easy access. Ideal for running, playing, and building sand castles. It has parking, a wooden walkway, and is usually supervised in summer. A small paradise within a protected area. **Surfing lessons and activities** are also offered during the season , perfect for those wanting to learn this sport. If you're looking for more tranquility, **Arnao Beach** —more sheltered from the wind and waves—is an excellent option for children. With a family atmosphere and a safe environment, it's ideal for spending a peaceful day by the sea.

In Oscos-Eo, nature isn't something you just look at; it's something you experience. Pools to splash around in, rivers and estuaries to row and sail , trails full of surprises, horses wandering through the woods... A region to explore outdoors, freely and playfully.

## Family surf lessons


